Works Commenced July 2012

Preparatory works began mid-year and included the delivery of the first transformer to site via the Parks Victoria entrance.



Delivery of transformer, Rooney St, October 2012

This 'temporary' transformer is required to ensure that the power supply from the Terminal Station is not interrupted during the project works. It will be removed when construction is completed.

Thank you to all those along Rooney Street, Madden Grove and Burnley side road for keeping the route clear of parked vehicles for the delivery of the transformer.

There will be several transformer transportations over the duration of the project. You will be notified in advance if you live along the delivery route of these transportations.

Works scheduled for 2013

In early 2013 we plan to commence the construction works required to upgrade the terminal station. When plans are finalised we will notify the community.
