Trading halt request – AusNet Services Ltd.

AusNet Services Ltd. (ACN 603 317 559) (**AusNet**) requests the implementation of a trading halt in the ordinary shares of AusNet (ASX Code: AST) prior to the commencement of trading today.

AusNet provides the following information for the purposes of ASX Listing Rule 17.1.

APA Group (ASX: APA) has issued a release to the market today 'Confirmation of Proposal to AusNet Services' (**APA Announcement**).

- 1 The trading halt is requested pending an announcement by AusNet to enable AusNet to consider its response to the APA Announcement and to provide the market with all relevant information, which may be considered to be market sensitive information in relation to AusNet.
- 2 AusNet requests that the trading halt remain in place until the earlier of:
 - (a) an announcement being made by AusNet to the market; and
 - (b) the commencement of trading on 23 September 2021.
- 3 AusNet expects that the trading halt will be ended by the announcement referred to above.
- 4 AusNet is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted.
